Nominations

Prospective entrants for the Awards program should visit www.queenslandtourismawards.com.au and follow the prompts to nominate and pay an entry fee via the online Awards portal.

Please note that all nominations must be lodged via the online Awards portal by **Thursday 1 June, 2017**. Submissions will not be accepted unless you have nominated by this date.

The judging of the Queensland Tourism Awards is coordinated by the Queensland Tourism Industry Council (QTIC). QTIC is a not-for-profit membership organisation, representing members' interests by providing a broad range of services.

If you do not notify our office before your site inspection, there will be no refund on your nomination fee. Refunds will not be given after the closing date for entries, **Monday 21 August 2017**.

Submissions and images must be uploaded by **5pm Monday 21 August**. Entries received after this date **WILL NOT** be accepted.
